## **ACTION PRESENTATIONS**

Councilmember Crist moved to approve the Source Water Protection Plan for the Hazel Creek Lake and Forest Lake, prepared by the Watershed Management Commission; seconded by Councilmember McCord.

John Buckwalter reported this is the first published document prepared by the Watershed Management Commission. It emphasizes and outlines increased monitoring of the lakes, and calls for a program of education and development of stakeholders' input and cooperation in protecting the source water. If approved, the Plan will be signed by the Commission on the 15<sup>th</sup> and forwarded to the Missouri Department of Resources for review and approval.
