ACTION PRESENTATIONS

North Water Tower Monitoring Unit

Councilmember Crist moved to authorize the City Manager to enter an agreement with MicroComm, Incorporated, for the design, supply and installation of a remote tower monitoring unit for the north water tower on Brewington; seconded by Councilmember McCord.

John Buckwalter reported that two out of the four elevated water towers are currently capable of monitoring the water level. Recent development in the northern part of the system and extension of the city's system to the north annexation area has increased the urgency for installing a monitoring system.

Liquor License Renewals

Councilmember McCord moved to approve the renewal of liquor licenses for the merchants holding said licenses for the annual period commencing July 1, 2006; seconded by Councilmember Crist.

Laura Guy explained this is the first half of the renewals, and the remaining half will be brought to the Council at their June 21st meeting.
