The City Council of the City of Kirksville, Missouri, met in a Special Session on Monday, December 12, 2005, at 5:00 p.m. in the Kirksville City Hall Council Chambers.

PUBLIC HEARING

Mayor Rowe opened the Public Hearing at 5:00 p.m. to hear citizen comments regarding the proposed 2006 fiscal year budget.

Laura Guy reported that the proposed budget of \$23,312,027 consists of 20% for police, fire and street services; 18% for water and sewer accounts; 34% for infrastructure improvement and capital replacement; 5% for economic development sales tax, and the remaining 23% for administrative and support services.

There being no further comments, Mayor Rowe closed the public hearing at 5:07 p.m.
