## PUBLIC HEARING

### *Proposed Water Improvements*

Mayor Masten opened the public hearing at 5:00 p.m. Mari Macomber explained the public hearing is being held for citizen comments on proposed water improvements. John Calise of Benton and Associates presented a presentation outlining the work that has been completed to date, and the proposed Water Treatment Plant Improvements – Phase I and IA/II, along with improvements to the southwest area of town with the installation of the Boundary Shepherd loop.

Councilmembers were given an opportunity to ask questions regarding the projects. One question concerned the plant capacity and future growth. John Calise explained that both Phase I and IA/II would bring the water treatment plant and the distribution system to a six million gallon capacity.

There being no citizen comments or questions, Mayor Masten closed the public hearing at 5:34 p.m.
