RESOLUTION NO. R2-1-594

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKSVILLE, MISSOURI, STATING INTENT TO SEEK FUNDING THROUGH THE MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND THE NORTHEAST MISSOURI SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT – REGION “C” AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PURSUE ACTIVITIES IN AN ATTEMPT TO SECURE FUNDING FOR THE CITY OF KIRKSVILLE

WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) protects, preserves and enhances Missouri’s natural, cultural and energy resources; and

WHEREAS, the Missouri’s solid waste management law became effective on July 9, 1990 with the signing of Senate Bill 530; and

WHEREAS, a major goal of Senate Bill 530 is to decrease the volume of solid waste being generated for landfill disposal by improving the planning practices and infrastructure for integrated solid waste management in Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the city does have areas of need which may be addressed by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources and the Northeast Missouri Solid Waste Management District; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Kirksville, Missouri, that it desires to participate with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources and the Northeast Missouri Solid Waste Management District in plans and activities for the improvement of our community.

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor of Kirksville, Missouri hereby is authorized to pursue and submit documents which are necessary in applying for funding and establishing an administrative organization to implement activities.

Councilmember Chrisman moved to approve Bill No. 2010-06; seconded by Councilmember Kuhns.

Citizens have asked where they can dispose of hazardous waste. City of Mexico has a trailer with staff trained to collect the items. It is proposed to apply for a matching grant in the amount of \$30,000 for a household hazardous waste prefabricated facility for citizens to dispose of chemicals, purchase supplies, training and collection costs for one year of service. The facility would be located at the Public Works complex for the city and Adair County community, be staffed by trained Public Works employees; and be open by appointment every second and fourth Wednesday from noon until 3:00 p.m. The service would be at no cost to the residents of Kirksville and Adair County.

Missouri Rural Enterprise and Innovation Center (MREIC) Agreement
