BILL NO. 2013-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 12040 REGARDING BUSINESS LICENSES OF CHAPTER 14 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF KIRKSVILLE, MISSOURI.

Councilmember Edge moved to approve Bill No. 2013-08 on first reading; seconded by Councilmember Russell.

The City Council approved changes to the Business License Ordinance on January 28, 2013, regarding the character of applicants by eliminating the misdemeanor conviction and the type of felony conviction. The Council asked for another review of this language. The City Attorney determined the most effective process would be to eliminate the character section in its entirety.

There was a discrepancy in regards to the fee charged for storage warehouse businesses and the fee set by the ordinance. The City was charging \$10 per building, but the ordinance stated a charge of \$10 per unit, resulting in an undercharge. The

Council asked for a charge of \$10 per storage warehouse business license and an additional \$1 per unit.

ORDINANCE NO. 12044

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 12040 REGARDING BUSINESS LICENSES OF CHAPTER 14 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF KIRKSVILLE, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 12040 was approved by the City Council at a Special meeting on January 28, 2013; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council that the following amendment be made as follows:

Section 1. That Section 22 of Chapter 14 be amended, that was recently approved, by changing the wording as follows:

Sec. 14-22. - Neither performance bond nor gross receipts fee required.

(c) The annual license fee applicable to all businesses subject to this section is ten dollars (\$10.00), with the following exceptions:

(26) Storage warehouses for rental, each unit\$10.00

Each unit.....\$1.00

Section 2. That Section 32 of Chapter 14 be amended, that was recently approved, by removing paragraph (1) to read as follows:

Sec. 32. – Qualifications of all applicants generally.

The general standards herein set out relative to the qualifications of every applicant for a city license shall be considered and applied by the city clerk. The applicant shall:

~~(1) *Character.* Any prior felony conviction within five (5) years of the date of the application will cause the city clerk to deny the applicant a business license.~~

(2) ***Renumber as (1)***

(3) ***Renumber as (2)***

(4) ***Renumber as (3)***

(5) ***Renumber as (4)***

(6) ***Renumber as (5)***

(7) ***Renumber as (6)***

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage.

Section 4. The provisions of this ordinance shall be included and incorporated in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Kirksville, Missouri, as an addition or amendment thereto, and shall be appropriately renumbered to conform to the uniform numbering system of the Code.

Councilmember Edge moved to approve Bill No. 2013-08 on second reading; seconded by Councilmember Russell. Motion carried: Ayes – Mayor Detweiler; Councilmembers Edge and Russell. Noes – 0. Absent: Councilmembers Fajkus and Mills.
