MREIC UPDATE

The Missouri Rural Enterprise and Innovation Center met on December 17. The Commission discussed an upcoming legislative luncheon that the MREIC will be hosting to share information with our state representatives and senator. Representatives from Adair and surrounding counties will be invited to learn more about the work of MREIC and the relations and partnerships that are being formed across the northern part of the state in an effort to expand the MREIC service fostering entrepreneurial efforts.

KREDI UPDATE

KREDI held its monthly meeting on December 9. Debi Boughton gave an update on the annual employment report with the following summary: Total of 24 employers with 8 increasing, 6 decreasing and 10 employers retaining their employment level from 2007. Phil Tate gave his monthly report which included meetings with Wire Rope, Commercial Envelope and Reliant Hardwoods. KREDI is preparing the documentation to obtain the hangar building from the City and rent the ground on which it stands as was agreed upon several months ago. This transaction will be completed before the end of the year.

TIF MEETING

The Commission has been asked to consider approving a TIF for the Raul Walters Properties on the south side of Kirksville. This is the property that will house Orschelin, JC Penney, Stage and Long John Silvers Restaurant. The members of the Commission in attendance were in support of the project seeing advantages to its implementation that go beyond the shopping center. The developer is looking at a time line currently and is hoping to have approval from the Council that the City would be willing to move forward with a public hearing. This may require a special City Council meeting should the Council wish to accommodate a request for this.
