CHILD SAFETY SEAT TIPS

Our Fire Department would like to remind you to always use child safety seats, booster seats, or seatbelts when driving with your kids! Ninety percent of injuries and deaths of children in vehicle collisions come from unrestrained or improperly installed child restraints. Please buckle up your kids the correct way every time! Whether your trip is 1 mile or 100 miles, you can prevent this by buckling your child's restraint! Please see our child safety seat tips below:

- Don't use outdated restraints!
- Don't use secondhand restraints!
- Don't use restraints that have been in a vehicle that had an accident!
- Don't forget to tighten restraints every time!
- Don't forget we can all be good role models for our children by wearing our safety belts!

PET REGISTRATION

Our Police Department would like to remind you that, per City Ordinance, anyone who resides within the City limits and cares for an animal four months of age or older must license their animal every year. Licenses are FREE!

All you typically need to do is stop by the Police Department during normal business hours and bring proof of a rabies vaccination, if required for that type of animal (e.g. dogs and cats).

If your animal is classified by ordinance as a “restricted animal”, which includes pit bulls or mixed breeds that include pit bull, there will be additional licensing requirements. HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DROP-OFF REMINDER

We will be scheduling appointments for Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) drop off for all City residents between 9:00 am and 12:00 pm on Saturday, September 17, 2016, at the Public Works Complex, located at 2001 North Osteopathy! Please call Public Works at 660.627.1291 to schedule an appointment and ensure staff are available to assist you! The program does not include disposal of any commercial hazardous waste.

HHW applies to any leftover household products that contain corrosive, toxic, ignitable, or reactive ingredients. Items that will be accepted at the collection site include: aerosols, antifreeze, batteries (NiCad, alkaline, lead acid, and lithium), button, ballasts, bulbs (fluorescent and regular household), cleaners (water and ammonia based), corrosives, cylinder fire extinguishers, fertilizers, cooking oil, used oil filters, motor oil, gear, lube, paint (oil and lead based), pesticides / poison-pesticides, herbicides, insecticides, rodenticides, miticides, and fungicides.

REMINDER: PUBLIC WORKS ACCEPTS USED OIL

As a reminder, you can also dispose of your used oil during HHW drop off by bringing it to the Public Works Complex, located at 2001 North Osteopathy, on Saturday, September 17, 2016, from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm! We ask that you limit the oil containers to no larger than 5 gallons in size and in an original oil container. We recycle the used oil by using it in an oil burning furnace to heat our mechanic’s shop!
