The day is finally here! Months of fundraising and construction are coming to an end, and McKinney Bark Park is nearly complete!



## CITY DONATES TO ADAIR COUNTY HUMANE SOCIETY

The Adair County Humane Society (ACHS) plays a vital role in our community; they house stray animals, find loving homes for pets, and functions as the City's animal shelter. With an increase in costs and a decrease in donations, ACHS has a shortfall in their budget this year. The City recently made an additional one-time donation of \$9,000 to ACHS for services provided to the City. As a result of the donation, ACHS will create a task force to increase funding and look for ways to make ACHS a sustainable entity.
