CONTACTING THE CITY IS EASY

Have you ever had an issue you wanted to ask the City about, but you weren't sure who to ask? Perhaps you called the department you thought handled your complaint, only to find out you needed to speak with someone else. Or, maybe you reported a problem and wanted to know how it is being handled.

Now you can go online and report and track issues through the interactive Citizen Service Request Tracker (CRT)! Here you can submit requests regarding trash and debris, tall weeds and grass, potholes, ditches and culverts not draining properly, request public records, and the list goes on!



Report A Problem

Just visit www.kirksvillecity.com, and click the red "Report a Problem" button on the homepage. This will direct you to the Citizen Request Tracker, where you can choose the category and type of problem you would like to report. Once selected, you will see a login/registration page. If you want follow up

information regarding your complaint, *be sure to register!* You may also submit the requests anonymously; however, a valid e-mail address is still required. All you have to do is fill out the form, and it goes directly to the appropriate department. You can wait for updates, or log back in to see how your request is being resolved.




