## PLAN TO ATTEND THE CAPE AIR KIRKSVILLE AIR FESTIVAL

Get ready for the fifth annual Cape Air Kirksville Air Festival this September! Kirksville residents and visitors have come to know and love this annual event, which offers a variety of food, entertainment and extraordinary aerial demonstrations.

The Air Festival will take place at the Kirksville Regional Airport on Sunday, Sept. 9th, and will provide entertainment for both families and aviation enthusiasts, including a kid's zone, aircraft exhibits and food stands.

The air show will begin at 2 pm, and will feature a variety of performers who will demonstrate incredible aerial maneuvers. The acts include the US Army Golden Knight Parachute Team, Gary Ward in the Extra 300 who will fly upside down at low altitude doing amazing aerobatics, and Vlado Lenocho in the North American P-51 vintage Mustang. Back by popular demand are the Aerostars formation team and Bob Richards in the Pitts Special. Also Erik Edgren will once again be on hand in his Aeronca Champ and the US Air Force A10 Thunderbolt.

Admission is \$10 per person, children 5 years and younger are free. Admission wristbands are available at the Chamber of Commerce, 304 S. Franklin St., and at the event gate. Parking is free with admission.


## MUSICAL COMEDY DINNER THEATER AT JACKSON STABLES

## SATURDAY HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DROP OFF EVENTS

There are just two Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) collection events remaining in 2012. Drop off will be held September 8 and 22, from 9 am to noon.

The City is currently accepting appointments for disposal of HHW from 9 am to noon, on the two remaining dates. Citizens may call the Public Works Complex at 627-1291 to schedule their appointments. Scheduled appointments ensure that qualified staff is available to assist citizens with their disposal of eligible items. The program is limited to household waste and does not include disposal of any commercial hazardous waste. This facility is housed at the Public Works Complex, located at 2001 N. Osteopathy.
