CAPE AIR KIRKSVILLE AIR FESTIVAL COMES TO TOWN!

On the weekend of Sept. 10-11, airplanes and high powered jets will fill the sky above Kirksville as they land at the regional airport. These aircrafts will fly in from all over North America for the annual Cape Air Kirksville Air Festival!

The annual festival features an air show, extreme sports opportunities, and other aviation-related entertainment suited for the entire family.

Helicopter rides, airplane rides, tandem skydiving and a free kids zone will be available at the airport on Saturday, Sept. 10. Admission is free, and the rides can be purchased in person. Reservations for tandem skydiving can be made by calling the DuKum Inn at 660-665-9764 .

Sunday, Sept. 11, gates open at 8 a.m. Food stands, exhibits, and, of course, the air show are highlights of the day. The air show will take place at 2 p.m. A host of acts will be present to perform amazing aerial maneuvers. Kirksville area residents and visitors are encouraged to bring lawn chairs out to enjoy the overhead entertainment. Helicopter rides, airplane rides, tandem skydiving will also continue to be available.



CITY STREET IMPROVEMENTS CONTINUE THROUGH 2011

The City of Kirksville has been repairing streets around the city. This year, \$150,000 has been allocated to curb, gutter, and storm drainage, and \$570,000 for asphalt and concrete pavement. The project list of needs far exceeds available funds, so the City uses a Pavement Condition Index (PCI) to measure street conditions and determines priority based on this measurement. The following chart lists the streets that have been selected for repair for 2011.
