BLUEWING DR. - East to Pintail Dr.

GARDNER ST. - from Osteopathy St. to Centennial St.

COTTONWOOD ST. - from Franklin St. to Elson St.

PIERCE ST. - from First St. to 100 ft. east of Third St.

COME FLY WITH US AT THE 2010 AIR FESTIVAL

If you enjoy a variety of food, extraordinary aerial feats, or just want to see a jet-powered Port-O-Potty, bring your family out to the Kirksville Regional Airport for the **Depot Inn and Suites Kirksville Regional Air Festival!** The festival will take place Saturday, Sept. 11 and Sunday, Sept. 12, and will provide entertainment for both families and aviation enthusiasts.

Saturday from noon to dark will feature food stands, exhibits, a kid's zone, helicopter rides, glider rides and tandem skydiving. Plus, the performers for Sunday's air show will be landing throughout the day.

Sunday's activities begin at 8:00 am and feature free local airplane rides by Kirksville's new air carrier, Cape Air. Rides will be limited to the first 100 people, so plan to arrive early to reserve a seat. Food stands, exhibits, a kid's zone, helicopter rides, glider rides, and tandem skydiving will also be available.

The air show will begin at 2:00 pm on Sunday and features a variety of performers who will demonstrate incredible aerial maneuvers. The Air Force A-10 East Demo Team, Skip Stewart in the Pitts Special and Vlado Lenoch in the North American P-51 Mustang are just a few of the acts. In addition to the air performers, families are sure to enjoy Paul Stender's demonstration of the School Time Jet-Powered School Bus and the Jet-Powered Port-O-Potty!

Admission for both days is \$10 per person or \$30 per carload, with free admission for children 5 years and younger. Admission wristbands are available at the Chamber of Commerce, 304 S. Franklin St., and at the event gate. Parking is free with admission.
