



CITY COUNCIL SEATS UP FOR ELECTION

The Kirksville City Council has two positions that will be filled at the general municipal election on Tuesday, April 6, 2010. The City Clerk's Office had five residents file, but only three met the qualifications for placement on the election ballot. Please exercise your privilege to vote for two of the three candidates: Richard L. Detweiler (incumbent), Tony Fajkus, and Aaron Rodgerson (incumbent).

Each term for City Council is three years. Citizens will have a chance to meet all the candidates at the Candidates Forum sponsored by the Kirksville Area Chamber of Commerce on March 25, 2010.

TRASH CONTRACT UPDATE

The current contract for trash collection services will expire in March, 2010. The City of Kirksville and Veolia Environmental Services are in negotiations regarding a new trash service contract and will have a new agreement in place before April 1. The new contract for trash collection services will include 65 gallon trash carts, provided by Veolia, and disposal of one oversize item (television, recliner, mattress, etc.) each week. The addition of this oversized item will eliminate the need for an annual Spring Clean-up and allow residents to dispose of oversized items on a regular basis. The elimination of the Spring Clean-up will also save residents a little money each month because the City will remove the \$.50 Clean Up Fee that is currently on every water bill. This fee will be removed from the bills that are mailed out at the end of February.

KIRK-TRAN ADDS ADDITIONAL BUS TO FIXED ROUTE

Effective February 1, 2010, Kirk-Tran will add an additional bus to its Fixed Route Schedule. This means a Kirk-Tran bus will be at each of the 20 stops every 30 minutes!

The Fixed Route operates Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. and includes the stops listed to the right. The route schedule is repeated every 30 minutes, and may vary by 10 minutes before or after the scheduled time. Children 9 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Fare - \$2.00 per one-way trip. Purchase a booklet of 10 tickets for \$15.00 from the Fixed-Route Driver or Kirksville City Hall. You must have exact change for fares or to purchase booklets. Children 5 and under ride free.
