

## CITY COUNCIL SEATS UP FOR ELECTION

The Kirksville City Council has two positions that will be filled at the general municipal election on Tuesday, April 6, 2010. The qualifications for a councilmember are:

- 21 years of age prior to taking office
- United States Citizen
- Live within the City for one (1) year prior to the election
- Current in all City, State and Federal taxes and other City accounts, including water bills

If you are interested in running for one of these positions and meet all of the listed qualifications, you may file your candidacy with the City Clerk's office located on the first floor of City Hall, 201 South Franklin Street, between the hours of 8 am and 5 pm, Monday through Friday. Each position is for a term of three years.

The filing period for this election started on December 15, 2009 and will close on January 19, 2010. At the time of publication, there were four citizens who had filed for the open positions, they are: Richard L. Detweiler, Kevin A. Alm, David Lee Mountain, and Tony Fajkus. Voters will be asked to cast two votes at the April 6th election.



## RECYCLING MADE EASY

The City of Kirksville's curbside recycling program makes recycling simple and easy to do. Once a week Veolia Trash Service, the trash collection company, sends a truck around to all households in the City to pickup recyclables curbside. The same type of truck that picks up trash is also used to pick up recyclables. There is no limit on recyclable materials. The cost for the service is included in the trash collection fee. Materials should be bagged or bundled according to type of recyclable.

Currently, the following items are picked up:

- \*All types of metal containers
- \*All types of plastic containers
- \*Newsprint
- \*Computer paper
- \*Magazines
- \*Corrugated Cardboard
- \*Paper Board
- \*Mixed Paper

Paper and cardboard items should be bundled separately from the rest. Cans and plastic can be bagged together. Items not bundled, should be bagged in transparent bags. Although our current vendor does not have a market to recycle glass, Truman State University has a recycling location that citizens can use for glass recycling. This site is located at their recycling center on La Harpe Street. It is then ground up and used for fill materials. ## KIRK-TRAN ADDS STOP TO FIXED ROUTE

Effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, Kirk-Tran will add Devlin Place (pick up on S. Porter St.) to its Fixed Route Schedule. The Fixed Route operates Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. and includes the stops listed below. The route schedule is repeated each hour. Times may vary by 10 minutes before or after scheduled time. Children 9 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Fare - \$2.00 per one-way trip. Purchase a booklet of 10 tickets for \$15.00 from the Fixed-Route Driver or Kirksville City Hall. You must have exact change for fares or to purchase booklets. Children 5 and under ride free.
