APPLIANCE PICKUP PLANNED FOR JUNE

The City of Kirksville is negotiating with a local recycling company to schedule an appliance pickup for Kirksville. Citizens will need to purchase a sticker at City Hall to participate in this pickup. The exact cost of the stickers is not known but it will be a flat fee regardless of whether the appliance contains Freon. Appliances eligible for pickup include dishwashers, clothes washers, dryers, air conditioners, stoves, refrigerators, freezers, and water heaters. This pickup will occur around the middle of June, and the exact date and process for obtaining stickers will be advertised as soon as we have the final agreement. 
