ADAIR COUNTY/CITY OF KIRKSVILLE EMERGENCY SERVICES CELL PHONE REGISTRATION DRIVE



In February 2007 the City of Kirksville activated its new emergency Automated Telephone Notification System (ATNS). The system was designed to provide mass emergency notifications to the public in real time.

Even though the system was obtained by the City of Kirksville, it was designed to include all of Adair County. The system has the capability to contact every household in Adair County, with a recorded warning message, within approximately 15 minutes. Smaller notifications to specific areas can be made much quicker.

The system was designed to use landline phones to notify residents of risks within their immediate area. The system can also contact cell phones, but the cell phone owner must register the cell phone number through the E 9-1-1 Center.

Any Kirksville/Adair County resident who would like to have their cell phone linked with a specific address can register to do so at www.kirksvillecity.com. Cell phone numbers will be treated as confidential and only be collected for the purpose of input into the ATNS system. These cell phone upgrades will be in addition to, not in place of, the hard-wire connectivity. You can link more than one cell phone to each location.

City Utility Bill Payment Options Reminder

Utility customers with the City of Kirksville have several options when it comes to paying their utility bills each month. These options include online payment, direct debit and the traditional in-person and mail service options.



Online—Customers have the opportunity to access their service accounts online, pay online and receive e-bills instead of paper bills. Log on to www.kirksvillecity.com and follow the Water/Sewer Online Payment link. Account payment initiated through the City’s website can be made by credit card, debit card or electronic check. (Payments initiated through a bank’s internet site are received as paper checks and are late if received in the mail after the 20th of each month.)

Direct debit—Customers also are offered the opportunity to sign up for automatic withdrawal from their checking or savings account for the amount of the bill. Bills will still be mailed showing all charges for the month. Contact 627-1251 for more information on how to sign up for direct debit and ensure that payment is never late.

In-Person—Customers can pay utility bills in person at City Hall, Monday-Friday, 8 am to 5 pm or payments can be dropped off 24-hours a day at one of our convenient drop boxes. The City has two drop boxes, one located at City Hall near the Franklin Street entrance and the other drive-up location on Franklin Street just across from City Hall.

Mail—Customers always have the option of mailing their utility bill payments to City of Kirksville, 201 S. Franklin Street, Kirksville, Missouri, 63501.

Payment of utility bills are always due on the 20th of each month. Billing inquiries can be made through e-mail to utilityadmin@kirksvillecity.com or by phone at 627-1251.
